Writ Petitions under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in these circumstances stated therein and in the respective affidavits filed therewith the High Court will be pleased to

issue a WRIT OF CERTORARIFIED MANDNAMUS or any other writ, order or direction in the nature of writ calling for the records pertaining to the impugned order in F.No.R. 17014/ 164/ 2013-2018-EP(H) dated 03.08.2018 passed by the 1st respondent in so far as reducing the seats as 50 for the petitioner college for admission to BHMS Degree Course for the academic session 2018-2019 quash the same and direct the 1st respondent to issue a corrigendum mentioning the number of seats as 100 seats instead of 50 seats for admission to BHMS degree course for the academic session 2018-2019 to the petitioner college (in WP.No.21959/18) and;

(ii) To direct the 3rd & 4th respondent to allow the petitioner college (Dr. Hahneman Homeopathy Medical College and Research Centre, Koneripatty Panchayat, Rasipuram Taluk, Namakkal District) to admit 100 students (65 government seats and 35 seats by the management) for the 1st year BHMS Degree course 2018-2019 in the counselling to be held on any dated pending disposal and subject to the outcome (in WMP.No.25749/18) pending in WP.No.231959/18 respectively.

Order: These petitions coming on for orders upon perusing the petitions and the respective affidavits filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.G.MASILAMANI Senior Counsel for M/S.A.THIRUMURTHY Advocate for the petitioner in both the petitions and of M/S.M.T.ARUAN Advocate on behalf of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in both the petitions the court made the following order:-

Mr.M.T.Arunan, learned counsel takes notice for the second respondent. Notice to the respondents 1, 3 and 4 returnable in two weeks. Private Notice is also permitted.

- 2. Prima facie, this Court is of the view that the impugned order is in violation of principles of natural justice and was passed contrary to the recommendation of the second respondent and the orders passed by this Court earlier for the previous academic year.
- 3. The learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner stated that once intake of seats was granted by the second respondent prior to 2003, it cannot be reduced without due process and that the recommendation for allowing admission, enabling the petitioner's College to admit students, cannot be ignored by the first respondent.
- 4. It is further stated that the petitioner had the permission of the first respondent to admit 100 students and that the petitioner is enjoying such benefits from 2013.

5. Having regard to the above facts, there shall be an order of interim direction to the respondents 3 and 4 to allow the petitioner's College to admit 100 students (65 Government seats and 35 seats by the Management) for first year BHMS Degree course 2018-19, subject to the final outcome of the writ petition.
